You may or may not know what caused the disruption. The second type is a gap between your current state and a desired state, or goal. If you aren't sure how to bridge that gap, you have a problem. For example, you might want to find ways to meet a new consumer need. Or you might want to improve your own efficiency in terms of managing your time, meeting sales targets, or designing products. Everyone needs to solve problems, from the trivial to the life-threatening, at some point.
